SURVEYS IN SHANGHAI .

Mr. H. Jackson of the Shanghai Dockyards, called on me recently en route to England. Mr. Jackson is the Engineer who carried out a few part surveys for Owners and whose reports on these surveys were forwarded to you. He is not returning to Shanghai and consequently the proposal that he carried out surveys on behalf of the Society could not be implemented even if approved.

He informed me that he had examined the screwshaft of the steamer "EUSTON" on the 30th May last, and found everything in order and that the ~~4th~~ ^{5th} bush had been rewooded.

I note that the notation "Surveys overdue" has been recorded in the cases of the "JOAN MOLLER" and "NORELG" and I would suggest that this notation be retained as long as possible in these and similar cases.
