This ship is classed BS (with Freeboard), with the Notations 'ss. Sh. 8,48' and 'A.S. 11,50'.

The last record of drydocking is 11,50.

The class is subject to defective shell rivets in way of deep frames in deep tanks (p & s) being renewed, and to permanent repairs to centre girder riveting in No.3 D.B. tank at the next drydocking.

In reply to enquiry the Hong Kong Surveyors in a letter dated 7.5.52 state that the Owners were advised of the outstanding surveys due, but until now no reply has been received.
