Reverting to your letter of the 3rd instant, I have to inform you that the Reports of surveys held at Honolulu, Yokohama and at Cebu between February and May have now received the consideration of the Committee.

As a result of these surveys, class has been continued subject, inter alia, to the wasted combustion chamber stays in the starboard boiler and the defective smoke and stay tubes and air heater tubes (plugged and thin) in all three boilers being renewed at the earliest opportunity and by the end of September, 1964.

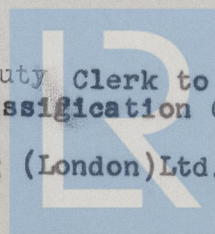
I shall be glad to learn, therefore, what arrangements can be made for the repairs to the boiler being carried out at an early date.
