Montreal Report No. 5893 - "LANSDOWNE PARK"

In reply to the queries contained in the Classing Letter dated the 17th September last, regarding the above Vessel, Mr. Brown now confirms as follows;-

- (1) The spacing of the rivets in the treble rivetted butt laps of the strake below the sheerstrake in the wells is 3-1/8". ✓
- (2) A horizontal girder has been fitted to the after peak bulkhead - ✓
- (3) The material used in the construction of this Vessel has been tested as required by the Rules - ✓
- (4) The only part of the main structure which has been electrically welded is the paravane stem piece. ✓
- (5) The length of the double bottom tank should read 270'-0". ✓
- (6) Bridge and forecastle decks - The length of bridge deck between bulkheads is 78'-0" with 4'-0" overhang at after end, making total length of 82'-0". ✓
- (7) The length of the forecastle deck was taken from the forecastle front to forward perpendicular -
