Nature of Survey

This vessel was completed at Hull in June 1922, but the classification has been deferred for the completion of the Machinery ^{Survey} Report.

The Hull Surveyors were informed in July 1922 that the Committee were prepared to record the date of build as January, 1922, provided an opportunity was afforded to make a general examination of the vessel in dry dock before she left that port.

Action has since been deferred owing to the vessel being laid up.

The Hull Surveyors now report the vessel has been placed in dry dock and damage through grounding repaired as follows:—
3 shell plates, 3 frames and 3 floors renewed, and 9 shell plates 12 frames, one reverse frame, 5 floors and 2 bulwark plates faired or repaired and minor repairs effected.

The bottom has been recoated and the vessel generally examined and found satisfactory.

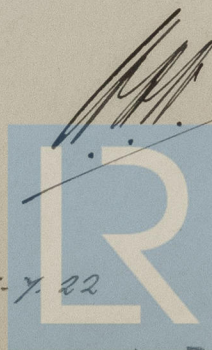
It is submitted as regards the hull that the vessel is eligible to be classed 100A1 with record of survey 12,23 Hul.
