This vessel was completed at Hull in June, 1922, but the classification has been deferred for the completion of the Machinery survey. *Reversing Engine to be tried under steam.*

The Hull Surveyors were informed in July, 1922 that the Committee were prepared to record the date of build as January 1922, provided an opportunity be afforded to make a general examination of the vessel in dry dock before she left that port.

The Surveyors stated in August last that nothing had been decided regarding the general examination of the vessel in dry dock, but she would be placed in dry dock before leaving Hull.

The same Surveyors now state in reply to enquiry that the vessel is still laid up.

It is submitted action be deferred.
