


Motorship "WALCRAG"

Mr. Rolland, the Owners Superintendent and Mr. Minde the Owners Representative, visited this Office today concerning our letter of the 30th April.

Mr. Rolland pointed out that on the occasion of the survey at Rotterdam in March (Rotterdam Rpt. No. 53552) the Surveyor was instructed to complete the General Examination for postponement of the Special Survey. He went on to say that most of the items listed for completion of this examination in our letter of the 30th April, had been covered by a recent Annual Load Line Survey.

The case has been discussed with Mr. Allan who has agreed that sufficient has been done at Rotterdam and at London where the Load Line Survey was held, to agree to a postponement of the Special Survey until April, 1963.

Mr. Allan considers however, that the Rotterdam Surveyors should be asked to explain why a complete General Examination was not carried out when the ship was at their port.
