Dear Sirs,

When considering your report No. 12279 of Special Survey and alterations for increased tonnage and draught effected to the Steamer "DEBORA", the Classing Committee spent much time in considering the extension of class which had been approved both for this ship and for the sister ship "ADELINA", namely the addition of the service limits "Coastwise between Singapore and Foochow" to the existing limits of "For Eastern Archipelago Service."

They have asked me to instruct you to make it clear to the Owners that this extension of class only covers these ships if they do in fact proceed routed coastwise.

Accordingly before assigning this amended class to the two ships in question in the Register Book, they would like to have an acknowledgment from the Owners that they fully understand the limitations imposed by the word "Coastwise".
