The Surveyors recommend that the vessel be placed in dry dock for further examination at the first suitable opportunity.

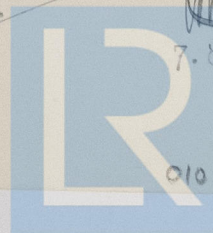
It is submitted action be deferred and the Owners informed of the Surveyors' recommendation.
