This ship was built at Southampton in April 1954 to be classed 100A1 "For Nigerian Coasting Service", and the class was deferred until a report was received from the Surveyor at Lagos of the satisfactory condition of the ship after arrival at Nigeria.

A Report 8 has now been received from Lagos stating that a satisfactory examination has been held on the ship.
