Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 2nd ultimo regarding the completion of the classification survey of the steamer "PATHFINDER". In such cases it is customary for the additional fee for the final examination to be paid by the Owners, and in view of the fact that the full fees for the survey during construction have been paid by the builders, it is not thought that any further charge could reasonably be debited to them.

It appears that the Nigerian Government are unwilling to meet the fee and expenses in connection with your examination of the ship, and in the circumstances you should not press the matter.

The necessary amendments should accordingly be made in your books in the usual way.
