Ladders Renewed.

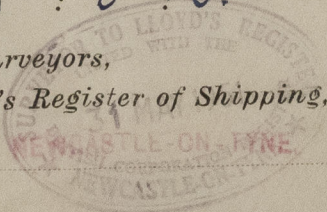
