ANSWER

I shall be glad to learn what arrangements the Owners have made for the Main Boiler and Special Surveys, due at the end of June and August respectively, to be carried out.

The Society's Surveyors at Glasgow reported in May last that the sternbush wear-down was $\frac{1}{4}$ " which is considered the practical limit before re-wooding. You should draw the Owners' attention to this matter and let me know what arrangements they propose for the sternbush to receive attention.

Date:— 19th October, 1961

The Owner states that the ship is now converting into motor vessel. a diesel engine of 505 H.P. will be installed.

Owing to reasons of economy the ship will be classed only R.I.NA.
