VESSELS BUILDING IN U.S.A.

SYNTHETIC RESIN INSULATED
CABLES.

In a number of Reports received from the U.S.A. on vessels in which the wiring has been carried out with synthetic resin insulated cables, the Surveyors have recommended that these be specially examined at the end of two years. The insulation referred to in American documents as synthetic resin is the same as that known in the U.K as Polivynl Chloride (P.V.C) This material is approved and is covered by Circular No.1805 and is considered satisfactory for the normal period between periodical surveys and that examination every two years is not necessary.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY SUBMITTED that the recommendations of the U.S.A. Surveyors in this connection be disregarded.
