It was recently approved that Mr. Engledow should accompany this vessel to Ferrol for examination in dry dock, he stating that this course was recommendable as some work would require completion.

From the telegram now received from the Cadiz Surveyors it appears the vessel has been docked at Gibraltar and some repairs effected. The Cadiz Surveyors state the Owners require classification certificates for Government trial next week, and that the same should be vise by Spanish Consul.

The certificates of classification cannot be issued until after the trial, unless the Surveyors have previously seen the machinery working. It is not known whether all the requirements have been complied with, but provided this is so, and the fees have been paid, the Surveyors might be authorised to issue a preliminary certificate stating that the vessel has been built under the Special Survey of the Society and is recommended by them for the contemplated classification.
