
IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned Acting Surveyor to this Bureau did, at the request of Jardine, Matheson & Co., Limited, Lloyd's Agents, Taipei, Taiwan, attend the single screw steel steamship "Mastro Stelios" 7195 gross tons of Piraeus, Greece on the 9th day of March 1960 and subsequent date as the vessel lay afloat at Kaohsiung, Taiwan in order to carry out condition survey of vessel's auxiliary boiler. Auxiliary Boiler Survey


The auxiliary boiler was examined internally and externally together with its mountings, fittings, insulation, refractory and casings and found satisfactory.

Setting of the safety valve was not verified due to insufficient time to raise steam. It was stated that the safety valve would be tried at a subsequent date.

The aforementioned pressure vessel is considered in a suitable condition for continued reliable operation subject to compliance with paragraph 2.
