With further reference to our letter of the 13th July and our telegram asking you to be good enough to cancel this letter we were under a misapprehension as to the vessels' possible future trading and as we are arranging to fit cargo battens as opportunity offers we should be pleased if no notation to the effect that cargo battens are not fitted be made in the register. The hatch covers, however, are a different matter and we have no objection to a notation that hatch covers on the second deck are not fitted being made in the register book.

We shall be glad if you will kindly, therefore, delete the reference to hatch covers on the certificates and return these to us, and oblige.
