Trawler "MARCHEGIANI III°"

In reply to your memoranda of the 4th July, 30th September and 28th October we have to state that after repeated letters since the 6th of July and finally a cable dated 2nd of November to the Owners requesting their intention with reference to the Special Survey due in August last, we have now received a reply to the effect that following the change to Italian flag the vessel was submitted to a complete classification survey, as a trawler, with the R.I. at Ancona and is now fishing in the Atlantic from where it is expected to return to the Port of Civitavecchia in the first half of December next. (The survey with R.I. was carried out during the period covered by the above correspondence.)

The Owners state that although they are compelled by law to maintain the R.I. class they have no desire to renounce the class with the Society but they request the Committee to accept as valid the surveys carried out by the R.I.

It is assumed that in these circumstances this case will be submitted to the Committee with a view to the appropriate action being taken.
