It is confirmed that the ownership of the vessel changed in the Port of Sydney from The Australian Coastal Shipping Commission (The Australian National Line), to Mr. Bruce Stuart of 163 Clarence Street, Sydney, at 1000 hours Saturday, 20th February, 1960.

The ship was purchased "as she lies" at No. 3 Buoy, Longnose Point, and subsequently moved by new owners to Storey & Keers shipyard 0900 hours 18th March, to be prepared for towing overseas.

The "Delungra" was taken in tow by the "Jamsons" (ex "Cobargo") and departed from Storey & Keers Wharf 0645 hours 3rd May, 1960, for Hong Kong.
