IN COMMONWEALTH OWNED "D" CLASS VESSELS.


I am directed to inform you that the Australian Shipping Board has decided to withdraw from your classification the refrigerating machinery on all "D" class vessels now in service, which are namely :-

"DCRRIGO"	"DELAMERE"	" DANDENONG"	"DAYLESFORD"
"DALEY"	"DUBBO"	"DELUNGRA"	"DULVERTON"

Also, the Shipbuilding Board has been advised that classification for the refrigerating machinery of the vessels "DENMAN" and "DONGARRA", no in course of construction, will not be required.
