I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant from which I regret to learn that it has not yet been possible to obtain any definite statement from the Owner in regard to the Special Survey which is now overdue.

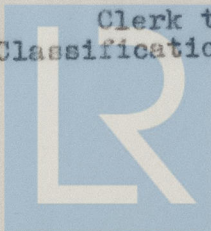
The position is that a Modified Special Survey, valid for twelve months, was held in January, 1960, and the validity of the Certificate issued expired at the end of last January, there being no period of grace for a Modified Special Survey. In view of the third, fourth, fifth and eighth paragraphs of Jacksonville report No. 2287, it is not considered that class should be maintained any longer unless a full Special Survey is held. I have, therefore, been instructed to cable you, as per copy herewith, and shall be glad to learn, in time for the Committee meeting here on 28th April, whether any definite proposal is forthcoming from the Owner.

If no satisfactory arrangement is made by then, the Committee will, in all probability, expunge the class seeing that the ship will be three months beyond the expiration of her last Certificate.
