I acknowledge your letter of the 3rd instant and have submitted this case to the Committee today, who in the circumstances have given instructions for a notation of "Class withdrawn at Owners' request" to be recorded against this vessel's name in the Register Book.

Mr. de Lasala, the writer of the letter of the 3rd instant, has recently called at this Office on several occasions, when the whole case has been fully discussed with him, and it was stressed that from our angle the ship did not pass a complete Special Survey at Genoa, but only completed a survey partly held at Hull in July, 1957, which date was assigned in regard to the Special Survey. As regards the Boiler Survey, this also was only completed at Genoa, and when the vessel changed ownership, she held a notation of "B.S. 7,57".

It was understood when I last saw Mr. de Lasala that he would furnish details of the items of which he complained, and he was assured that if this were done the case would be taken up with the Surveyors concerned.
