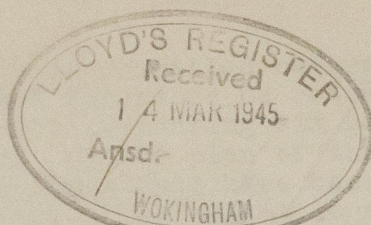

In reply to your Classing Letter enquiry of the 9th instant we have to inform you that the watertight bulkheads should be reported as follows:-

Total number of W.T. Bulkheads in vessel:-

Extending to upper deck - 6.

Extending to deck next below - 7.

The width of the keel plate is 55 $\frac{5}{8}$ "

The rudder coupling is fitted vertically.

The tank in way of the tunnel from frames 14 to 31 is 51' 0" long and has a capacity of 335 tons.

Verified copies of the approved plans of fore and after peak and middle line bulkheads for the Partially Fabricated "C" Type are enclosed.

Please return the plans for dealing with sister vessels building.
