With reference to Newcastle Report No.  
88653 on the steamer "ANGLO AFRICAN" and to your  
Assignment Letter of 26th ultimo, I have to report :-

- (1) Two tarpaulins have been provided for each  
bunker hatch on the freeboard deck. ✓
- (2) Wood plugs have been provided for all air  
pipes. ✓
- (3) The scupper from the crews' wash house on  
the freeboard deck aft is being replaced by one of larger  
size fitted with valve at ship's side.

I may add that the vessel is undergoing  
repairs in dry dock which she will leave in a day or two.
