Motorship "LENDAVA"

I am in receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant with enclosure and note that this ship is now laid up at Rijeka as a fuel storage vessel and that the Owners do not desire surveys to be held.

In their letter, the Owners ask for withdrawal of class "until further notice", and it is concluded from this that they in fact wish to defer carrying out any surveys until the ship resumes normal service.

In such cases as this the Committee are always prepared to allow the class to remain undisturbed on the understanding that all outstanding surveys will receive attention before the ship returns to normal trading, and I shall be glad if you will discuss this point with the Owners and let me know whether this arrangement will meet their requirements rather than have the class withdrawn and have to seek reclassification at some later date.
