Herewith we acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 21st instant, and in reply to your enquiries concerning report No. 17,897 on steamer "TOLWORTH" we may state that the spacing of the rivets through frames and shell plating amidships are 6 diameters apart centre to centre at sides, and 7 diameters apart centre to centre at bottom, and the sizes of the forecastle deck beams are as approved.
