No surveys are due on these vessels.

Communications have now been received from the Chief Surveyor for the U.S.A. & Canada, forwarding a letter from the Owners requesting that these vessels be withdrawn from the Society's classification.

This follows a decision by the Owners (conveyed in a letter from the Society's New York Office in February last) to withdraw all the vessels of their fleet gradually from the Society's class.

The cases were before the American Committee on the 20th ultimo, when it was decided that the character of each vessel should be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class <sup>6,34</sup> at Owners' request.
