Ship's name "SIRENES" Port Osl. No. 9650

This ship was built in 1939-12.

SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 8,61 but postponement until 2 weeks beyond expiry of the year of grace was approved 3.8.62.

The class is subject to shell plate No.8 in 2nd, 3rd & 4th strakes below sheerstrake with framing in way (p.s. from fwd) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey.

ACTION is DEFERRED for Special Survey by 8,62.

The ship has been stated to have proceeded to Larvik where she is to be used as a storage.

The Notation "Surveys Overdue 8,61" appears in the Register Book.

The OSLO Surveyors report (10,62), ship generally examined afloat with a view to ascertaining her condition for use as a storage ship whilst lying at anchor at Larvik and report the ship in satisfactory condition.

In a letter dated 26.10.62 the Oslo Surveyors state that they have been informed by the Owners that they would prefer the notation "Laid Up - Surveys Overdue" to be made in the Register Book.

In view of the above the case is submitted for the information of the Committee.
