I have surveyed the above-named ship in accordance with the Rules for Damage stated whilst berthing at Lyttelton on the 10.7.67 and confined to the soft nose and fo'c'sle flair plating.

For further particulars please see Report 10 attached.

Now Done:- Soft nose plating above fo'c'sle deck renewed along with fo'c'sle flair plating from soft nose to first bulwark stay, port and starboard. Bulwark rail faired in place where set down above soft nose. Steel platform between first bulwark stays, port and starboard, removed, faired and re-welded back into position. Forepeak air pipe cropped above fo'c'sle deck and renewed.

I declare that the items detailed in this report (except as stated otherwise) comply with the requirements of the Merchant Shipping (Cargo Ship Construction and Survey) Rules 1965, applicable to this ship, and are in all respects satisfactory for the service on which the ship is intended to ply namely International voyages/voyages within the limits
