and were reported to be on the *7th March 1944* at *Prince Rupert, B.C.*

in good, efficient, and safe working condition, at a pressure of
250 lb. per square inch on the main ^{W.T.} boilers. The approved
working pressure of the donkey boiler is *x* lb. per square
inch.

The Record *LMC 344* (Lloyd's Machinery Certificate)
has been made in the Register Book, subject to Periodical Surveys
as required by the Rules, and to the masthead + side light wiring + all
other P.V.C. cables fitted on deck being examined before the end of *346*.
