In reply to the enquiry contained in your classing letter of the 14th instant respecting the case of the motor vessel "COOPERATZIA" Hamburg Report No 19200 I have to state that the new propeller blades fitted in place of the damaged ones were spare blades which were on board the vessel. The material of the spare blades is bronze but as certificates of test of the material were not produced nothing is known here regarding the quality of the bronze in the blades. The propeller boss is also of bronze.

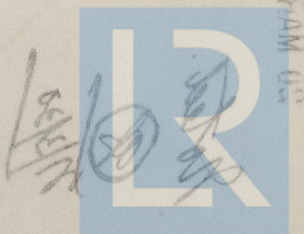
