
Parts now examined:—

Main Engine:— All cylinders, liners, covers, valves, valve gears, pistons, gudgeon pins, bushes, connecting rods, bottom end pins and bearings, main bearings and journals, camshaft and bearings, governor gear and all attached pumps.

Auxiliaries:— Lister and Paxman-Ricardo Diesel generator engines in their entirety together with their attached pumps and coolers (tested).
Auxiliary air compressor.
General service pump.
Fresh water circulating pump.
Fresh water cooler (tested)
Electrical installation (meggar tested).
