Before dealing with the First Entry Reports on the machinery of this vessel, I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know the moment of inertia of the new propeller, since it is observed there is a calculated critical not far above the maximum running speed.

Plans of the sterntube and screwshaft do not appear to have been submitted, and your comments in this respect will be appreciated.

With regard to the "As fitted" plan of pumping arrangements I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know whether Rule requirements have been satisfied in all respects.
