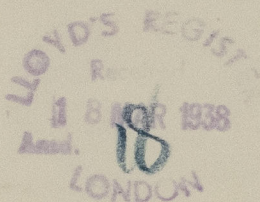

No. 6 Boiler.	"	35/64".	"	33/64".	"	23/32",
