The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The requirements for Vessels Not Built Under Survey and of a PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY have been complied with - see endorsement dated 15.7.48, but CLASSIFICATION has been WITHHELD for machinery.

The NANTES Surveyor reports (3.49) the ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated and a number of repairs effected to fractures in the longitudinal and transverse bulkheads in Nos. 1, 6 & 9 cargo tanks.
