Replying to your letter of the 30th instant, I beg to inform you that the Owners expect, subject to the approval of the Government, that the classification Survey will be completed at the Chantiers de la Loire, at Saint-Nazaire ; but they cannot state on what date exactly. They presume that, in all cases, it will not be before the 15th of September.

They are pleased to know that an Electrical Surveyor from United Kingdom will join the local Surveyor, and they are of the same opinion as the Owners of the "ESSO-BRETAGNE", namely : that the local Surveyor should be acquainted with the Society's experience of this type of ships' machinery and be guided accordingly.

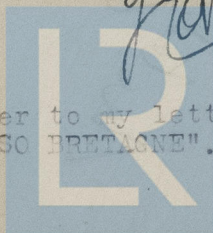
