10,448 tons gross of Le Havre, whilst lying afloat at the plant of the Maryland Drydock Company, Baltimore, Maryland, on the 3rd June, 1948, for the purpose of witnessing lifting tests of the two 5 ton derricks at the dry cargo hold hatchway.

By means of wire ropes and a spring balance, a load of 6 1/4 tons was applied to the 5 ton derricks, being 25 per cent in excess of the safe working load. The derrick was at an angle of 45°.

The above mentioned tests were carried out to my satisfaction as regards the stresses imposed by the test loads mentioned.
