PARTICULARS OF DEFECTS, REPAIRS, ALTERATIONS, ETC.

Stbd. Main boiler 18 plain and 2 stay tubes renewed.

The attention of the Owner's representative was drawn to the sternbush check ring fastenings, one of which required renewing, and the remainder further examination. Also the main switchboard required extensive cleaning and these defects were not dealt with by the time of the final survey.

The reason for repairs must be stated and those on account of damage, the alleged cause of which must be given, should be detailed separately from wear and tear repairs. State what action has been taken regarding items which are subjects of class. State also where appropriate, for the information of the Technical Records Dept., the material of the defective item and whether it is a forging, casting or welded fabrication. Any alterations in existing particulars in the Register Book should be reported above.
