The Committee have had before them a report of the survey which was held on this ship between June and August last by the Society's Surveyors at Bremen, from which it is noted that as she will be employed on the iron ore and coal trades, the cargo battens were removed.

Instructions have therefore been given for the notation "Cargo battens not fitted" to be inserted against the vessel's name in the Register Book.

A notation of B.S. 8,52 has also been assigned in respect of the Boiler Survey which was held on the above occasion, together with records of docking and screwshaft examination 7,52.
