Service" "DTf - Oil FP above 1500P".

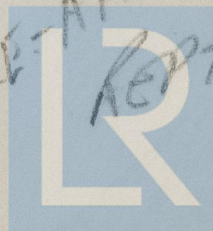
Before this class can be assigned,
