With reference to London letter dated 30th July, 1948, regarding Liverpool Report No.127270, I have to advise you as follows:-

- (1) Height of brackets at sides in engine room is ^{see plan} 3' 6".
- (2) Bridge deck beams $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3 \times .30$ OA. spaced 22". ✓
- (3) Horizontal stiffener on aft peak bulkhead $6 \times 3 \times .40$ OA welded toe on. ✓
- (4) Thickness of raised quarter deck plating clear of hatchway .30". ✓
- (5) Thickness of upper deck stringer plating and plating are in accordance with the approved plan. ✓
- (6) Lengths of poop, ^{house} raised quarter deck, bridge & forecastle are 57.5', 103.3', 9.2' and 23.7' respectively. It is regretted that these were omitted from the report. Please see Rpt.C.11.
- (7) Steering arrangements and windlass tried under working conditions and found satisfactory.
- (8) Vessel dry docked at Liverpool. Date of undocking 30/4/48. ✓
