FOUND

The Freeboard Markings as set forth in the original Certificate dated London, August 10th, 1922 to be plainly marked on the vessel's sides as follows:-

From centre of disc to top of statutory deck line at swining deck	10 ft. 7½ In.
Fresh water line above centre of disc	7½ "
Indian Summer line above centre of disc	7½ "
Winter line below centre of disc	7½ "
Distance between the top of statutory deck line on vessel's side and the intersection of the continuation of upper side of iron deck with the vessel's side at swining deck	12 "

A Report has been forwarded to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, to which is attached the original Freeboard Certificate, dated London, August 10th, 1922 for cancellation in order that a new Freeboard Certificate may be issued.
