SHIP'S NAME "HOLLYBRANCH" REPORT Sou No. 24150

The Southampton Surveyors report a dry docking held in July 1956 for commencement of the ES due 3.56. This survey was not proceeded with and the vessel has been towed to a Dutch Port.

In a letter dated the 13th April the Rotterdam Surveyor stated that they are informed the ship will not be broken up as was previously anticipated but will be re-sold.

In view of the fact that apart from the examination of the propeller and sea connections, the ES due 3.56 has not been held, and the BS due 10.56 not yet commenced, —

IT IS SUBMITTED for consideration whether this vessel's class should be deleted.
