The SPEZIA Surveyor reports (5,56), ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated and various recommendations for wear and tear and damage commenced but not seen completed as at this stage the Owners decided to retain the classification of the ship with the Registro Italiano only, and requested the withdrawal of the Society's class.

The above information has already been received by London Office, and in a letter dated 15.5.56 the Committee gave instructions for a notation to be recorded in the Register Book indicating that the class of the ship had been withdrawn at Owners' request.
