M.V. "CAPE HAWKE"

We thank you for your letter of the 15th instant in connection with differential nuts on the above-named vessel. This vessel was in Leith in July last, when the nuts of No. 1 cylinder were examined and passed by Mr. Davies. This is shown in the Certificate dated 25th July which also states that the nuts of No. 3 and 4 cylinders are to be examined by September last. We do not know why No. 2 cylinder nuts are not mentioned. At Leith, when the No. 1 cylinder nuts were examined, they were found in good condition and, as the date was considerably before the time allowed, the other side rod nuts were not examined. Since then the ship has been abroad and is at present on a voyage from Korea to Western Australia, via Christmas Island. We regret that the examination of the nuts was not attended to abroad and can only ask you to let us defer their examination until the vessel's arrival at a port in Western Australia, probably Fremantle. We are writing to the Chief Engineer instructing him to get this done.
