- (3) Postponements already agreed:— On 26th September 1962 the Committee agreed to a General Examination being held in drydock before the end of November with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey for a period to be determined by the condition as found at the General Examination. Due to delays the Committee agreed on 29th November to the General Examination being deferred until December and on 21st January until the end of January/early February, but no longer.

- (4) New Proposal:— The ship will not be returned from Indonesian Charters until mid-March (5 months after due date of SS.) and, on arrival at Singapore, will probably be laid up or sold. The Owners ask the Society's requirements for the issue of a Leadline Certificate for two or four years as an unclassified ship. Ship 35 years old.
