

Further to our letter of the 21st instant relating to the Assignment of Load Lines in the case of the above steamer, we have to inform you that the vessel has now been examined by us on a pontoon and subjected to a General Examination with Class Contemplated and when temporary repairs to Boiler room double bottom tank end (port side) and port side floors have been completed (at the end of this week), she will be eligible for record of Examined (in red) 1,4,1 and the Freeboard Certificate could be made valid for one year e.g. to the end of January, 1942.
