From this letter, you will observe that they intend from the 10th instant, to engage the above ship in a trade between Havre and Port-en-Bessin, which latter port is situated on the Normandy Coast, 100 kilometres W.- S.W. from the former, and we desire to know whether the Society could grant a certificate for such voyages, which would be 5 or 7 in number annually.
