Barge "SHELL SERVICE VI"

We intend to have gas oil revictualings at Port-en-Bessin from our Havre stores.

Our barge "SHELL SERVICE VI" built in 1930 at the Chantiers de Normandie and classed by you for trade in rivers and estuaries, would be absolutely suitable for the trade we are intending for.


The deadweight of such barge, i.e. 530 tons, would never be reached, as we intend to have her carrying 300 tons per voyage.

The annual number of voyages would be 5 or 7. As the distance between Havre and Port-en-Bessin is of about 100 kilometers only, we would have the vessel towed by a first class Company - for instance, the Société des Abeilles, of Havre - and we have thought it more convenient, for facilitating our steps with the Insurers in view of the obtaining of a convenient insurance, if you could grant us a classification certificate enabling us to make such voyages.

We beg you to tell us, as soon as possible, if you think you will be able to give us satisfaction, as the first voyage intended for should take place on the 10th August.
