With reference to my letter of the 20th instant respecting the Lighter "SERVICE SHELL VI", I beg to acquaint you the Committee have had before them at their meeting to-day a First Entry Report from the Society's Surveyor at Rouen and that the vessel has been classed ~~as~~ 100A1 Barge, For River and Estuary Services subject to the handle of the drain cock at the O.F. service tank being weighted in order that the cock may be self-closing and to valves being fitted on the discharge pipes at the ship's sides. Notations of "Carrying Oil Fuel in Bulk, F.P. above 150°F" and Lloyd's A & CP have also been assigned.
